

Cotton Bags

Background

One of the short-listed entries for the Arts Project was a mosaic design for A Child's View of Whitchurch by the Rainbow Brownies. It was not possible for the design to be realised as a piece of art, due to the amount of work that would have resulted for the designer.

However, it was considered to be too good an idea to waste and the image will be used on cotton shopping bags. These will be supplied to retail outlets in Whitchurch. They can be claimed by householders by presenting a voucher from the Update newsletter, delivered to all households in the town. The idea is to get people in Whitchurch to use their local shops.
